




# 1. Bioeconomy vs biobased economy

- Bioeconomy: use of renewable biological resources from land and sea, like crops, forests, fish, animals and micro-organisms to produce food, materials and energy.
- **Biobased economy**: only non-food use of biological resources.

For the year 2021, the Knowledge Center for Bioeconomy shares the following data for the biobased sectors (excluding food and feed):




**12.5 millions** people employed

**47 billions** euros turnover












- Circular Wallonia strategy :
  - Circular economy regional strategy
  - 2021 2024, budget of 200 millions of euros
  - Biobased economy as a cross-cutting priority
  - Valbiom : coordinator of the biobased actions










Together, these organizations contribute to making **Wallonia a leader in the bioeconomy**, driving economic growth while ensuring environmental sustainability.
